

Installation Procedure

Step 1:


Remove the Base(1) and caster components from the package. Using the Open-end Wrench(C) provided in the tool kit, screw the Casters(4) clockwise into the Base.

Next, take out Center Post(2) and invert it. Align the four holes on the Base with the four circular holes at the bottom of the Center Post. Secure the Base to the Center Post using M6 Long Screws(a), and then tighten them using the 5.0mm Wrench(A/B) from the tool kit.


(As shown in the graphic below.)

Tips:

Please ensure the foot brake is before locked installing the Casters.



Invert the Metal Basket(6), then slide it downward along the track groove of the Center Post to the installation position shown in the photo below, where it is secured in place.


This is the position where the Metal Basket is installed on the Center Post.

Step 2:


As shown in the image, align the sliders on each component with the front and rear slots of the Center Post(2). Slide the sliders to the desired height in sequence, then tighten the fixing screws to secure them in place.







Center Post section view



Tips:
Level the Caster by adjusting it with an Open-end Wrench.


Step 3:

As shown in the figure, first insert the Center Post(2) into the hole beneath the Desktop Tray(3). Then, use the M6 **Short** Screws(b) to secure the Center Post to the Desktop Tray from above. Finally, tighten the screws using the 5.0mm Wrench(A/B).




Step 4:

Unscrew the two existing fixing screws on the side of the Desktop Tray(3). Then, take out the Oral Scanner Holder(7) and align it with the holes on the side. Finally, use the Ross Wrench(D) from the tool kit to securely tighten it. Mount the scanner on the left or right side as needed.




Step 5:

As shown in the figure, remove the protective film and attach the Non-slip Mat(8) securely onto the Desktop Tray(3).

Product Care and Maintenance
